An Independent Education

When student differences such as prior ability, socio-economic status and average performance of a pupil's school are taken into account, attending an independent school in England from the junior / prep years:

. adds the equivalent of two additional years of schooling by the age of 16;





- contributes an additional 0.64 of a GCSE grade across each of a candidates' best eight grades;
- . generates superior pupil performance at the ages of 4, 8 and 10.

- Entry based on Higher
- One sitting
- Minimum entry requirements
- Does not always reflect degree of difficulty of course
- Applications from SV: be aware of UCAS application deadlines: 15th January 2017. Research necessary in summer





- Oxbridge
- Recent leavers: Newcastle, Northumbria, Bath, Durham, King's, RAC
- Must normally do sixth year
- 3 Advanced Highers, generally at A or B
- Fees of up to £9,000 p/a
